All the names of God are comprehended in this one of good. Furthermore, he is the efficient cause of all good, by an overflowing goodness of his nature. Truly God is good."

In the gift of his only-begotten Son, God commended his love to us, in that while we were yet sinners, in due time Christ died for the ungodly.
